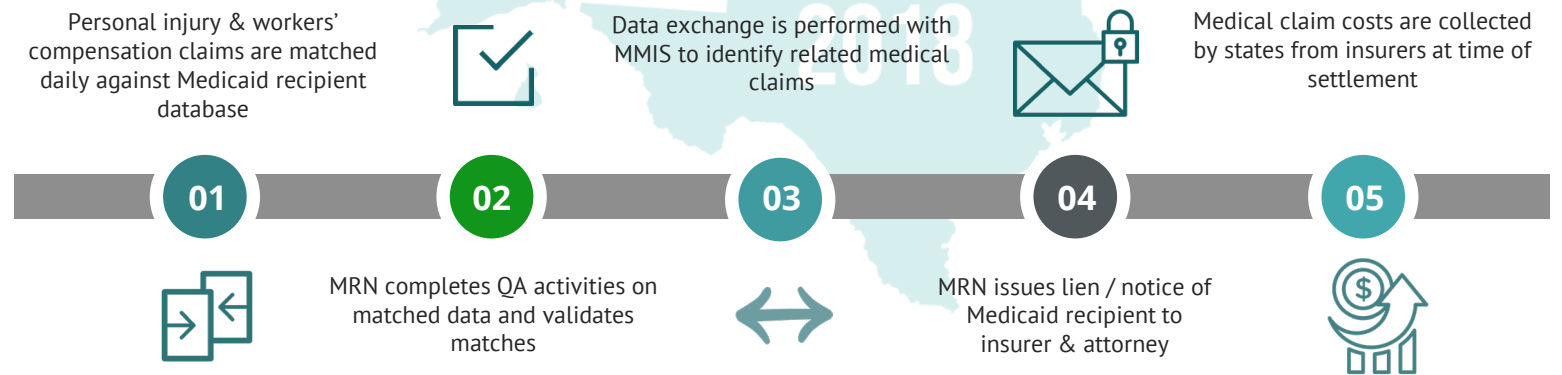

ORIGIN & MECHANICS

The **Medicaid Recovery Network (MRN)**, originally the Medical Assistance Intercept System (MAIS), was designed to address Article 11 of the Rhode Island FY13 Budget law (P.L. 2012, Ch. 241), which created R.I.G.L. Chapter 27-57.1, the Medical Assistance Intercept Act. **The daily electronic matching of Medicaid recipients with liability and workers' compensation claims allows MRN to easily identify qualified claims early in the claim lifecycle and as a result, allows states to recover greater medical claim costs from insurers at the time of settlement.** **Rhode Island** was the first member to join the program in **2012**, followed by **Texas** in **2018**. Since its launch, MRN has become an invaluable solution for states to mitigate overall medical assistance claim costs.
